Job Description: The Anderson Fire Department is accepting applications for an eligibility list for the position of **Seasonal Firefighter**.

Open Date: May 14, 2018 8:00 a.m.

Closing Date: June 1, 2018 5:00 p.m.

Salary: \$11.50 per hour.

Job Requirements: Minimum Requirements

1. High school diploma or equivalent
2. 18 years of age
3. Valid CA driver license
4. Valid S-SV EMS EMR or EMT – I
5. Valid Health Care Provider CPR card
6. I-100, I-200, S-130 and S-190
7. Fire Control 1, 2 and 3
8. Haz-Mat FRO or FRA
9. Pass arduous pack test
10. Pass DOJ background

Duties: Seasonal Firefighters will be assigned to one of the 3 shifts who work a 48/96 shift schedule. The Seasonal Firefighters' typical shift will be 24 hours the first day, and 14 hours the second day (Before starting their shift's 4 days off). The firefighter's primary duties will include responding to emergencies as directed by the Shift Captain. Duties include but are not limited to firefighting, medical emergencies, rescue activities, and out of district assignments. The firefighter will be responsible for maintaining station and equipment readiness and cleanliness at all times. The firefighter will report to the Shift Captain and work under his or her direction at all times. The firefighter will participate in all training activities as directed by the Training Officer or Shift Captain.

Qualified Candidates will be contacted regarding interviews. **Veterans Preference Points will be granted to individuals who have received Honorable Discharge from their military service, two points will be added to a Veteran's final score if a copy of their DD214, indicating Honorable Discharge, is attached to each employment application before the closing date.**
