SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 2020-1 OF THE ANDERSON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT DISSOLVING COMMUNITIES FACILTIES DISTRICT NO. 2005-01 (VEGETATION MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES) AND ORDERING THE RECORDATION OF AN ADDENDUM TO THE NOTICE OF SPECIAL TAX LIEN

Pursuant to Government Code Section 36933(c), the following constitutes a summary of Ordinance No. 2020-1 introduced by the Anderson Fire Protection District on August 11, 2020 and scheduled for consideration of adoption on September 8, 2020 at its meeting held in the Fire Hall of the Anderson Fire Protection District 1925 Howard Street, Anderson, California.

The Anderson Fire Protection District is enacting an ordinance pursuant to Section 53338.5 of the California Government Code to dissolve Community Facilities District 2005-01 (Vegetation Management and Maintenance Services) because the CFD has no obligation to pay any debt and has no authorization to levy any special tax. The vegetation management and maintenance responsibilities will not be taken over by the Skyview Estates Homeowner's Association.

A certified copy of the full text of the Ordinance is posted and available for review in the Office of the Anderson Fire Protection District Office at 1925 Howard Street, Anderson, California. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective thirty (30) days after its adoption and shall be published and posted as required by law. This Ordinance was introduced by the Board of the Anderson Fire Protection District on August 11, 2020 and is scheduled for consideration of adoption on September 8, 2020.

Fire Chief's Report

September 8, 2020

Department Update(s)

- The staff has again started the process to begin the impact fee study and service fee schedule for the department. Along with this, we have met with City Staff to renew our services agreement contract for them collecting our fees.
- Continue to work on updating the policy and procedure manual.
- We should be receiving FEMA SAFER grant reimbursement any day.
- Cal OES Incident Support Unit has been delayed due to the fire activity statewide.
- E246 has been covering Cal Fire stations since August 18th.
- We will have the second reading of the resolution to dissolve the community facilities district for Skyview.
- Action Item to adopt the Fy20/21 final budget, not much change from the preliminary budget. Revenues are up and so is the cost of PERS. We are still awaiting reimbursement from the SAFER Grant.
- Action Item to unrestricted money from the equipment fund to pay the invoice for the ballistic vest purchase. \$2,500 was covered from monies donated by Clean Rite Built Rite.
- Call volume is back to normal and even slightly higher than average.



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- The process to fill the vacant captains position was placed on hold due to the fire activity statewide and the candidates have been notified.
- Working on revamping the department website so we can update it more often and complete the build out.

Investigations

- Follow-up on open cases as time allows.
- The preliminary hearing for the Cottonwood arson case has been changed to October 2020.

Meetings/Significant Events

• Meeting with our cooperators to establish countywide protocols on how we will respond to an active shooter/mass violence incident. We are hoping to have a county wide drill November 2020.


