Residential Burn Permits No Longer Required for the Anderson Fire Protection District

Effective November 1, 2016 The Anderson Fire Protection District shall no longer require permits for residential open burning. Property owners must comply with all applicable rules and regulations regarding “Permissive Burn Days” as determined by the State Air Resources Board, the local Air Pollution Control District, and Cal Fire.

As a reminder !!!!!

**NO BURN BARRELS
NO BURNING OF STUMPS
NO HOUSEHOLD TRASH OR GARBAGE CAN BE BURNED
NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS CAN BE BURNED
ONLY DRY, NATURAL VEGETATION, GROWN ON THE PROPERTY MAY
BE BURNED**

Burn piles must not exceed Four Feet in diameter and must have at least a Ten Foot clear area around the burn pile. A water source and shovel must be available near the burn pile and the burning must be supervised – not left unattended at any time.

Violations of burning regulations are a violation of
Health and Safety Code Section 42400 HS

BURN DAY INFORMATION

Burn Day Information Number – 530-244-8777 after 9:15 am

Burning Hours – 10:00 am to 3:00 pm (fire must be out by 5:00 pm)

Burning not permitted during unsafe weather conditions.

(e.g., winds greater than 15 mph)

Agricultural Burning and... Burning for Construction purposes still requires a permit from the Air Pollution Control District or Air Resources Board.

Contact the appropriate agency for specific rules and necessary permits for burning other than “residential burning”.
