This is an informational item only. No vote or other action should be taken.

DISCUSSION

In certain circumstances, when a Board Member is not present at Board Meetings for a specified period of time, that position will be deemed vacant. Specifically, Government Code section 1770(g) provides that an office becomes vacant by the officer "ceasing to discharge the duties of his or her office for the period of three consecutive months, except when prevented by sickness..."

In effect, a position will be deemed vacant if the individual does not appear at meetings for three or more months, <u>unless the failure to appear is due to a medical concern</u>. If a medical condition exists preventing appearances at the Board meetings, then the office is not vacant under California law.

While staff cannot get into any personal details of Mr. Yarbrough, a representation can be made that, pursuant to California law, there is not yet a vacancy on the Board. Mr. Yarbrough will remain a Board member until the election is held in 2022 or a letter of resignation is provided.

Department Update(s)

- The staff has again started the process for the impact fee study and service fee schedule for the department. Along with this, we have met with City Staff to renew our services agreement contract for them collecting our fees.
- Continue to work on updating the policy and procedure manual and is close to completion.
- Working on revamping the department website so we can update it more often and complete the build out.
- We have received all the ems supplies that were purchased from the Shasta Regional Community Fund Grant and all training, required paperwork and approvals have been obtained thru SSV EMS and we are now providing all services allowed in the EMT optional scope of practice procedures, including Narcan, epinephrine, aspirin therapy, advanced airway, and Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP). This is a big step in upping the level of service for our agency.
- We have begun to roll out the billing with Fire Recovery USA.




